

**AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT SIGNED BETWEEN DRC AND UGANDA AT  
LUANDA, ANGOLA, ON 06/09/2002**

After mutual discussion, the Head of State of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and his Ugandan counterpart agreed that the above-mentioned Luanda Agreement, concerning the complete withdrawal of Ugandan troops from DRC and the normalisation of the Cooperation relationship, be amended to establish a new framework for the implementation of the Ituri Peace Commission according to the updated timetable in Annex.
