Establishment of local commissions

- Order

Based on mutual agreement reached between the Chief of General Staff of the Croatian Defence Council and the Chief of General Staff of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina, under the chairmanship of General Morillon, UN Force Commander for Bosnia and Herzegovina and Ambassador Thibault representing EC Monitors, I

ORDER

- 1. Local joint commissions, composed of three members- representatives of the Army of the Republic of BiH and three members-representatives of the Croatian Defence Council, are to be established immediately in VITEZ, TRAVNIK, BUSOVAČA and KISELJAK.
- 2. Composition of joint commissions as well as the location where they will meet and hold talks is to be provided in writing to the Headquarters of the Central Bosnia Operational Zone and to the Headquarters of the 3rd Corps of the Army of RBiH.
- 3. Joint commissions have a duty to execute orders issued by the Joint Operations Centre which is located at the headquarters of the European Community Monitor Mission in Bila, Municipality of Vitez.
- 4. Local joint commissions shall supervise cessation of fire and propose to superior commanders of the Croatian Defence Council and of the Army of RBiH appropriate penal measures against violators.
- 5. Each commission is under obligation to create conditions in which full security is guaranteed to civilian population in its zone of responsibility, and competent bodies have a duty to ensure public order and peace.
- 6. Each commission shall undertake measures as necessary to prevent arson, destruction and stealing of property owned by citizens within the area under its control.
- 7. REPORTING

Pending institution of connecting links between the Operations Centre in Bila and all local commissions, joint reports signed by both sides are to be sent to the Central Bosnia Operational Zone and the 3rd Corps Headquarters.

Regular reports are to be provided every day until 20:00 hours, with the status as of 19:00 hours, while special reports shall be sent as need may be.
