THE SITUATION IN CENTRAL AMERICA: THREATS TO INTERNATIONAL PEACE AND SECURITY AND PEACE INITIATIVES

Letter dated 27 June 1990 from the Permanent Representative of Guatemala to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to transmit herewith the "El Escorial Agreement", signed at Madrid, Spain, on 1 June 1990, between representatives of the political parties of Guatemala and the Unidad Revolucionaria Nacional Guatemalteca (URNG). This Agreement comes within the framework of the "Basic Agreement for the Search for Peace by Political Means" and the commitments contained in the Esquipulas II Agreements.

I should be grateful if the text in question were circulated as an official document of the forty-fourth session of the General Assembly under agenda item 34.

THE EL ESCURIAL AGREEMENT

The Delegation of the Political Parties of Guatemala and the Unidad Revolucionaria Nacional Guatemalteca (URNG), in the presence of the Conciliator, Monsignor Redolfo Quezada Toruño of the National Reconciliation Commission of Guatemala (CNR), and the Observer designated by the Secretary-General of the United Nations, Dr. Francesc Vendrell, meeting from 27 May to 1 June 1990, for the purpose of implementing the decisions taken in the city of Oslo, Norway, and contained in the "Basic Agreement for the Search for Peace by Political Means" and with the aim of specifying actions and political means for the peaceful solution of the national problems and the enhancement of functional and participatory democracy in Guatemala.

State:

that, within the framework of the Olso, Norway, and Esquipulas II Agreements and having regard to the constitutional framework in effect in the Republic of Guatemala and to the express will to achieve a firm and lasting peace in our country,

They agree:

- 1. To ratify in its totality the "Basic Agreement for the Search for Peace by Political Means", signed in the city of Oslo, Norway, on 30 March 1990, by the delegation of the National Reconciliation Commission of Guatemala (CNR) and the delegation of the Unidad Revolucionaria Nacional Guatemalteca (URNG).
- 2. That, in order to achieve peace and the enhancement of the democratic system, it is necessary to promote the participation of all forces and political and social sectors in the definition of the whole body of institutional changes that will make it possible to achieve the full operation of the civic and political rights of organization and expression; independent economic development, general well-being, social justice and unrestricted respect for the independence of the powers of the State, in order to secure and guarantee the application of justice, respect for the integrity of the individual, honesty and probity in public administration and the defence and safeguarding of national sovereignty.
 - 3. The need is recognized to promote a process of revision and institutional reform that includes the legal order of the country, with the commitment to promote reform of the Political Constitution of the Republic by the mechanisms established therein and with the aim of achieving the goals of peace and the enhancement of functional and participative democracy, by efforts towards:
 - (a) The reconciliation of all Guatemalans;

- (b) The ending of the internal armed confrontation and the peaceful solution of national problems by political means;
- (c) Unrestricted respect for and application of the law.
- 4. Note is taken of the will of the parties to this Agreement to promote political means that will contribute to the solution of national problems and make feasible the incorporation of Unidad Revolucionaria Nacional Guatemalteca (URNG) in the political process of the country, by establishing the legal procedures for that incorporation so that they can participate in the National Constituent Assembly to be inaugurated by the legally registered parties in 1991.
- 5. With the aim of ensuring as soon as possible actions that will make it possible to achieve the goals of the process of peace and the enhancement of the democracy, it is decided to hold periodical meetings between the Delegation of the Political Parties and the Unidad Revolucionaria Nacional Guatemalteca (URNG), within the framework of the Oslo Norway, and Esquipulas II Agreements, using the same mechanisms for the appointment, verification and mandating of the Conciliator as are established in the first-mentioned Agreement and United Nations observers.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT BY THE DELEGATION OF THE POLITICAL PARTIES

The Delegation of the Political Parties accepts with satisfaction the statement of the Unidad Revolucionaria Nacional Guatemalteca (URNG) that it is not opposed to the 1990 electoral process and the decision:

- (a) Not to carry out actions against the electoral process of the country at the time of the elections;
- (b) To suspend acts of sabotage throughout the duration of the electoral campaign.

DECLARATION OF THE UNIDAD REVOLUCIONARIA NACIONAL GUATEMALTECA (URNG)

The Unidad Revolucionaria Nacional Guatemalteca (URNG) views sympathetically the fact that the Delegation of the Political Parties, here represented should have referred, in conceptual terms, to aspects of importance with regard to the grave crisis through which our country is passing.
