JOINT ACTION ON THE QRT REPORT

THE SIXTH GRP AND MULE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE MEETING WAS HELD ON APRIL 22-23, 1998 AT THE MARAWI RESORT HOTEL IN MARAWI CITY. THE GRP AND THE MILE PANELS ARE CHAIRED BY LITGEN JOSELIN NAZARENO AND ATTY LANANG ALI, RESPECTIVELY.

THE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE CONSIDERED AND DISCUSSED THE REPORT SUBMITTED BY THE QUICK RESPONSE TEAM (QRT) ON THE VISIT TO UPPER MINABAY, BULDON, MAGUINDANAO VIS-A-VIS COMPLIANCE WITH THE FEBRUARY 6, 1998 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PARTIES. FOLLOWING DISCUSSIONS ON THE REPORT, BOTH PARTIES NOTED THE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE QRT PERTAINING TO, AMONG OTHERS, THE REPOSITIONING OF TROOPS IN CERTAIN AREAS, AND SUSPENSION OF ALL LOGGING ACTIVITIES-UNFIL UNDERTAKE SUCH APPROPRIATE ACTIONS AS MAY BE PROPER AND NECESSARY IN ORDER TO PRECLUDE ANY DISTURBANCE OF PEACE IN

BOTH PARTIES REAFFIRMED THEIR CONTINUING COMMITMENT TO THE SPIRIT AND INTENT OF THE MARAWI AGREEMENT SIGNED OF THEIR CONFIDENCE BUILDING IN THEIR GENUING QUEST FOR PEACE.
