Inspirational messages from Delense Secretary Orlando Mercado, Maguindano Governor Zacaria Candao, and Mayor Muslimin Sema of Cotabato City highlighted the Opening Ceremony. Secretary Mercado challenged the GRP and the MILE Peter Panels to make compromises and find common areas of agreement so that a pencelul settlement may be reached. Gov. Candao and Mayor Sema reiterated their high hope and full support to the peace negotiations.

GRP Panel Chairman Lt. Gen. Edgardo E. Batenga AFP (Ret.), and Acting MILE Panel Chairman, Committee on Information Mohagher Iqual, representing MILF Panel Chair Aleen Abdulaziz Mimbantas, delivered opening statements for both sides, reliterating their sincerity and commitment to the peace talks.

During this meeting, both the QRT/IFFC and the CCCH presented their respective reports on the incidents in Carmen, Cotabato and Shariff Aguak, Datu Plans and Talayan, all in Maguindanao. The CCCH of the GRP and the MILF likewise presented their respective reports on the status of the implementation of the GRP-MILP

The GRP and MILF Peace Panels agreed to cluster the nine (9) Agenda items presented by the MILF for discussion in the Formal Peace Talks into six (6)

- Ancestral Domain / Agrarian Related Issues 1. 2.
- Destruction of Properties and Victims of War / Displaced and Landless 3. Human Rights Issues
- Social and Gultural Discrimination / Corruption of the Mind and Moral 4. 5.
- Economic Inequities and Widespread Poverty
- Exploitation of Natural Resources

The Technical Committees of both Panels were directed to discuss the following for submission to the Peace Panels: 1.

- GRP proposal on the modification/relinement of headings for the
- 2. Proposed organization and specific tasks of the Technical Working Groups which will discuss the Agenda Items;
- MILF Draft on Immunity and Security Guarantees, and GRP counter-3.



4. MILF Draft on the Comprehensive Agreement on Respect for Human Rights and Humanitarian Laws.
